When war breaks out, women often suffer the most – they experience trauma, sexual violence, and the death of their loved ones. When the conflict is finally over, the attention of the global public moves on, and it is up to the women left behind to rebuild their families and communities.

Women for Women International supports women living in some of the most dangerous places in the world. These women enroll in our one-year program, where they learn how to earn and save money, improve their family's health, and have their voices heard – at home and in their communities.

Since 1993, the organization has helped more than half a million marginalized women who survived wars in Afghanistan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Iraq, Kosovo, Nigeria, Rwanda, South Sudan, Ukraine, and Palestine.

With over fifty brutal and armed conflicts around the world, there has never been a greater urgency to support women who have survived war. With the help of donations, women can complete the training provided by Women for Women International, gaining the skills, knowledge, and resources they need to earn their own income. Our graduates pass on their knowledge to their neighbors and children, creating a ripple effect.
